Since 2008, the Meiden Group has promoted hands-on safety education to enhance employee awareness of potential hazards. From 2016, the education service expanded beyond the Group, providing fee-based education to workers at other companies'

factories and construction sites. The Group has also developed VR-based education, in which participants can virtually experience industrial accidents, using it for industrial safety education inside and outside of the company. JISHA has used Meiden's handson safety education content at its seminars for this purpose since 2021. In 2022, JISHA partnered with Meiden to develop VR-based content for such education.

The Meiden Group is putting top priority on safety and regards health as an irreplaceable asset, as stipulated in its Occupational Safety and Health Action Guidelines.
