Numazu Works (Shizuoka) receives Japan Greenery Research and Development Center Chairperson's Award under National Award for Greenery Factory program

Meidensha Corporation is pleased to announce that its Numazu Works, located in Numazu City, Shizuoka Prefecture, has received the Japan Greenery Research and Development Center Chairperson's Award as part of the Factory Greening Award Program (commonly refers to as the "National Award for Greenery Factory" program).



About the Factory Greening Award Program

The award program, which aims to promote factory greening, recognizes factories that have made outstanding achievements in enhancing both their internal and external environments. It is sponsored by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) and the Japan Greenery Research and Development Center.

The program offers four awards, each presented to factories based on their level of greening achievements. These awards are: the Japan Greenery Research and Development Center Chairperson's Award, the METI Director-General's Award, the METI Minister's Award, and the Prime Minister's Award (listed from the lowest to the highest level).

The Numazu Works received the award for the following achievements.

- Greenery occupies 17% of its premises, exceeding the benchmark of 10% stipulated by regional regulations.
- The facility pays careful attention to scenery, the environment, and the community by planting numerous trees around the factory buildings.
- The factory has continuously engaged in tree-planting activities for a long period since its opening. Japanese black pine and azalea are among the trees that have been planted.

• It actively engages in environmental preservation activities outside its premises, such as cleaning regional rivers.
